Additional information for projects covered in “From Tassels to Textures”

Patterns on the CD can be printed by your local printer on an A1 or A3. Please refer to the book for full instructions of all the projects.

Download Quilt.zip

Quilt block patterns and all other templates to be printed are on the CD (full size) in the project file or download from the mentioned websites to print on A4 pages.

Download the zip file needed, save & unzip. To use, double click the PDF file and print. Print all the pages needed on paper size A4, cut out and join together where they meet. It helps if you ‘put it together on a window’ to see the overlaps. Glue all the required sections together.

Quilt size – full size W37 ¼ “X L 47” (95.5cm x 120cm)

Download ‘Quilt.zip’ This zip file contains all the blocks needed to print on paper size A4

Quilt blocks: all blocks once constructed as a square should be 10 ½ x 10 ½” including ¼” seams. *Please add and mark all the blocks 1” bigger on the fabric before cutting to allow for shrinkage when stitching with the double needle. This is only required for blocks: A, Bi, Biii and Ci-iv. You may stitch all the blocks if you prefer. Only once this stitching is completed, cut to the original size.

*Block A: Block A -Full size: 10 ½ x 10 ½ “including a ¼”“ seam, incorporating all the sewing techniques mentioned in the book.

Block B- a guide only (color)

Note: If your printer does not print some lines on the sides, fold Bi in half and trace the leaf and ¼” seam of the top section to complete.

Repeat for Block B iii: trace the section not printed and the ¼” seam (plain block)

Individual blocks

*Bi: 5 ½ “ x 10 ½ “ – sew all the techniques

Bii: final size 5 ½” x 5 ½ “ - plain block with no stitching or echo quilt later

*Biii: final size 5 ½” x 5 ½ “ - fagoting and flower aromas

Block C: a guide (color)

Print 'C pattern pieces.pdf' Ci-iv. Only one block is needed as they are all the same. Rotate the blocks as shown on the guide.

Final size of each block 5 ½" x 5 ½" " including all seams.

Each block has a full fagoting strip and flower aroma

Print the following as well

- Transparent placement template (Quilt top placement file) for full and ½ flower for purple and red flowers -10 x 10" square.
Use this template to appliqué full flowers centered over stitched seams. See book pages 80 & 81 and the CD.
- Free hand quilting pattern (border of the quilt) Length parallel to the blocks – 10" long and the same height as the bobbin filled flower.
This free hand quilting design creates a 'shadow outline' of the stitched flowers and leaves on the opposite side blocks and should be the same size. If you do not want to print this, trace it from block Bi.
The corner design should be at a 45° angle.
- Quilt top Pattern pieces - to complete full velvet flowers on top of finished rows.
Book: Page 80 and 81

To join rows – refer to the CD for diagrams of rows and columns. 'PDF-Full Quilt complete.pdf' and 'PDF Full Quilt Small fitting.pdf'

Use the 'quilt top pattern pieces' and the 'quilt top placement template' to complete the full velvet flowers, 2 red and 2 purple. Refer to the book for full instructions - page 80 and 81.

Green Cushion: page 66

Download Green Cushion.zip

Cushion topper size: two sizes- decide if you want to make it with a narrow or a broader border
20" x 20" (51cm x 51cm) This size cushion was made with a 4" / 10cm green silk border.
18 1/4" x 18 1/4" (46.8cm x 46.8cm) border 3 1/8" (8cm)

Cream silk center: 11 5/8" square (29.5cm x 29.5cm) no seams

Quilting this section: Free hand quilting 1. Seams are included.

Green silk border height 3 1/8" (8cm- this can be made wider to 4" or 10cm)

Mark the mitering seams only. These will be trimmed after sewing the seams.
